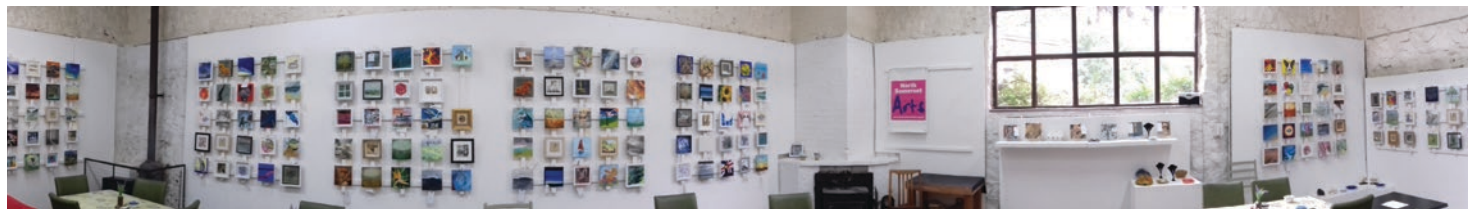
We know there are many arts and performance groups throughout the communities of North Somerset. There is a very rich cultural offering at local level, covering music, drama, poetry and the visual arts.
